Thank you for your communication with the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) Office of Civil Rights regarding Southern California Regional Rail Authority's (Metrolink) request for a waiver to allow the use of race conscious measures in Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program participation.

Pursuant to the provisions associated with federal regulation 49 CFR Part 26, the DBE program exists to ensure participation, equitable competition, and assistance to participants in the USDOT DBE program. FTA has completed our review of your agency's goal attainment, and has coordinated with the USDOT Office of General Counsel to determine that based on the postdisparity study utilization data, a waiver is not required to reinstate the use of contract goals as all disadvantaged business groups are currently underutilized. It is therefore acceptable for your agency to proceed with the reinstatement of race conscious measures in the implementation of SCRRA/Metrolink's DBE program.
