WHAT: Metrolink Railroad Tie Replacement Work

WHERE: On railroad tracks in Fullerton

WHEN: November 11 – December 2, 2019

MORE INFORMATION:

To keep train service safe and reliable, Metrolink crews will be doing tie replacement work on the train tracks in Fullerton just north of the Orangethorpe Avenue railroad crossing.

Preparation, cleanup and tie replacement work will occur weeknights between November 11 – December 2, 2019 from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

During this maintenance work, we anticipate the following impacts:

- Noise, dust and vibration from equipment backup alarms and heavy machinery
- Noise and vibrations from track maintenance activities
- Lights from light towers and/or on-track equipment

The work area is located near a Quiet Zone. According to Federal Railroad Administration safety regulations, trains may blow their horns due to work crews.

Please note all construction dates and times are subject to change without notice. There may be additional clean-up and preparation work before and after the project is complete
