WHAT: Metrolink Railroad Maintenance

WHERE: On Metrolink railroad tracks adjacent to Anaheim Canyon Station

WHEN: Monday, February 17 at 9 p.m. until Saturday, February 29 at 7:30 a.m.

MORE INFORMATION:

To keep train service safe and reliable, Metrolink crews will continue extensive railroad tie replacement work adjacent to the Anaheim Canyon Station. Starting on Monday, February 17, there will be work performed during the night and on weekends between February 17 and February 29.

- On weeknights, work begins at 9 p.m. and ends at 5 a.m. each morning
- Weekend work begins Friday, February 21 at 7:30 p.m. until Monday, February 24 at 7:30 a.m. and Friday, February 28 at 7:30 p.m. until Saturday, February 29 at 7:30 a.m.

During this work, we anticipate the following impacts:

- Noise, dust and vibrations from equipment backup alarms and heavy machinery
- Lights from light towers and/or on-track equipment

The work area is located adjacent to a designated Quiet Zone. According to Federal Railroad Administration safety regulations, trains may be required to blow their horns due to work crew on or near the tracks.

Please note all construction dates and times are subject to change without notice. There may be additional clean-up and preparation work before and after the project is completed.
